

Ottawa StoryTellers' COVID-19 Vaccination Policy
Approved October 4, 2021



All persons who are eligible for vaccination against COVID-19, including attendees, OST personnel, and performers, at all indoor OST events must be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days), provide proof of vaccination along with photo ID, and wear masks.

Until vaccinations are available for children 11 years of age and younger, children taking part in in-person activities must be masked. When vaccines are available for this group, proof of vaccination will be required for entry into OST events.

Individuals who cannot receive the vaccine due to medical exemptions will be permitted entry with a doctor's note until recognized medical exemptions can be integrated as part of a digital vaccine certificate.

The vaccination requirements for indoor events do not apply to outdoor events, though masks and social distancing are encouraged at outdoor venues.

In accordance with Ontario public health measures, gathering limits are 50% or less of seating capacity indoors and 75% or less of seating capacity outdoors, unless further restricted by local government or by the venue.

These requirements are also subject to the requirements of the venues. They will take effect as of October 4 and remain in effect until government authorities rule otherwise. Any performer who signed a contract with OST before October 4 will be requested to comply.
